



Uniform

All North Downs school uniform is available from:

All Children:

- North Downs Primary School v-neck sweatshirt or cardigan
- White shirt (preferably short sleeve) suitable for tie
- School tie (an optional tie 'on elastic' is available)

- Boys: grey long or short trousers
- Girls: grey skirt, grey pinafore dress or long grey trousers
- Girls summer uniform (optional): purple and white gingham dress

- Black shoes (not trainers) *please try and avoid laces unless your child is proficient at tying them!* Shoes should be sensible shoes, heels are not encouraged, nor are ballet style shoes, boots or open toe sandals.

- Boys: grey socks
- Girls: white socks or grey tights

- Backpack with logo/book bag with NDPS logo

PE Kit

- White T-shirt with logo
- Purple PE shorts
- Black plimsolls or trainers (NOT lace up) with non marking soles
- PE bag with logo

Optional, but recommended

- North Downs sweatshirt with hood
- Joggers with logo

P.E. Kit should be kept in school at ALL times. Kit should be left in school Monday to Friday and taken home regularly at weekends so it can be washed. Plimsolls and trainers should be kept in a drawstring bag suitable to hang on a peg (trainers may be worn for outside sports only).

Caps/Hats

In the summer term, we expect all the children to have a hat or cap with them to protect them from strong sunshine. This can be a NDPS cap, but does not have to be, although we would prefer it to be as plain as possible. (Purple, navy or black - no logos).

Jackets

The NDPS jacket is not compulsory, but we would ask that you choose a jacket that is dark in colour (purple, black, grey or navy) with no logo's or pictures. Thank you for your co-operation with this.

Jewellery

Please note that earrings may not be worn in Surrey Schools during P.E., games or swimming; your child must be able to remove these themselves for all P.E. and Swimming Lessons. Jewellery should not be worn at any time, but if ears are pierced small studs are allowed. If your child is going to have their ears pierced we recommend that you have this done at the start of the summer holidays, as they will be unable to do P.E. with earrings in. A non-expensive watch may be worn.

Hairstyles

We believe that hairstyles should be in keeping with our uniform. Children's hair should not be gelled, dyed, spiked nor have lines and patterns shaved into it. Long hair should be tied back. Hair accessories (bands and clips) should be simple and in the school colours - purple, white, grey or black.
