Gardening Club Plant Sale: after school next Friday 18th September, children from last year's Gardening Club will be selling pot plants after school. An ideal opportunity to support their efforts and re-stock your autumn gardens at the same time!

School Payments: as this is the start of a new academic year, we take the opportunity to remind you that we are now a cashless school. Our preferred method of payment is via our online system Tucasi. Every child has been issued with a registration code, enabling parents to create an account. Once set up, payments for school meals, trips, school-stocked uniform items etc. can all be made through this account. Items such as ties, sunhats and swimming hats paid for online will be sent home with the child. Please note that if necessary, it is still possible to make a payment by cheque (payable to North Downs Primary), but whenever possible, please use Tucasi. Thank you.

Parking: we also start the year with a general reminder about parking for drop-off and collection at school. Whilst our primary concern is for the safety of children, parents, staff and road users, we also ask for your consideration towards our neighbours and other motorists please...so avoiding hatched areas of the road, not obstructing driveways, entrances, corners etc. This would seem to be obvious, but the complaints received show they happen with worrying regularity. More specifically we have had a few parental concerns voiced at Leigh since the start of this term about school parking versus through traffic. Please leave sufficient space for traffic to pull into when the road effectively becomes a single lane with parked cars at the start and end of the school day. Also, we ask that you leave as quickly as possible once you have dropped or collected your child, to reduce congestion and free up space for arriving parents' cars. If parents would like the chance to socialise and catch up whilst their children play, may we suggest Leigh playground as a safe, secure and lovely park, with off-road parking, so ideal for purpose.

Tripod: a slightly strange request, but does anyone have a tripod gathering dust in their loft that they no longer want and which North Downs could have for filming assemblies etc.? If so, Miss Winslade would love to hear from you. Thank you.


