ParentMail Registration: a reminder that North Downs is a 'green school' and part of this involves our making every effort to eradicate paper communication. To this end, school to home communication is via email and text, using a 'ParentMail2' account. To receive these communications it is necessary for parents and carers to register with ParentMail and create this account - using a code supplied by the school and specific to the named child. This allows you to specify your chosen email address and mobile number (used for occasional 'emergency' texts, such as unexpected school closures). If you have not yet registered, please do so; if you no longer have your child's code, or it has expired, please see a member of the admin team to request a new code. Once you have created an account, you are able to see all previous communications, as well as make changes to your contact data etc.

School Website: to also assist in keeping parents fully informed, most whole-school communications (including the weekly newsletter) and many class/year group 'mailings' are posted on our school website at www.northdowns.surrey.sch.uk. If you ever miss or mislay a ParentMail email, with curriculum/homework sheets or newsletter etc., these are available to read and print from our website - as are many school forms...and a lovely selection of school photos! Do take the time to have a look at what's available.
