Dear Parents, Carers and Children

Safeguarding pupils, parents, carers, staff and visitors whilst in school is of the highest importance. It is for this reason that we ask for your cooperation in complying with the following:

- Pupils arriving after 9am must be signed in at the school office, to avoid their not being recorded on the school premises if they have missed Registration
- All visitors (including classroom volunteers) must sign in at the school office, to record their presence on school premises (in the event of fire etc.)
- Any known pupil absence should be advised in writing in advance
- Any unexpected pupil absence should be advised by phone before 9.30am on the first day, and...
- All absence must be covered by a written note for the school office on return to school
- If someone other than a parent is collecting your child, remember to sign the collection sheet in their classroom, or, if it is a last minute arrangement, phone your school office
