Please give the following information and advice your close attention...

Online Safety

In the ever changing world of technology we feel that educating the children about the potential dangers of being on the internet is crucial for their safety and wellbeing. At the beginning of each term at North Downs every class discusses and learns about how to stay safe online as well as using computers and other equipment correctly. We begin this in Reception by making sure that the children stop and ask an adult when they see anything on the screen that they are unsure of, we also make them aware of safety by using cartoons and videos to illustrate and reinforce this teaching. During Key Stage 1 we also show video clips and have discussions as well as using role play so that the children can see that 'stranger danger' is as important online as it is speaking to someone they don't know in the street or park.

At Key Stage 2 the children are beginning to spend a lot of time online and may face risks such as cyberbullying or being exposed to inappropriate content. Whether you're unsure about what happens online or are familiar with new technology, it's important that you talk to your child about staying safe. It may feel daunting, but you don't need to be an expert on the internet. Understanding what children do online and the risks they face will help you keep your child safe online.

What do children do online and through social networking?

Children and young people go online to connect with friends, and make new ones, to browse the internet for information, chat with others and play games. They may:

- search for information or content on search engines like Google and Bing
- share images and watch videos through websites or mobile apps like Instagram, Pinterest, Vine and YouTube
- use social networking websites like Facebook and Twitter
- write or reply to messages on forums and message boards
- play games alone or with others through websites, apps or game consoles
- chat with other people through online games, BBM (Blackberry Messenger), games consoles, webcams, social networks and tools like Whatsapp



Elasticated School Ties: we now stock elasticated school ties for sale at all our site offices, at a cost of £4.00 each. Our preferred method of payment is in advance via your Tucasi (ScoPay) account - you can then collect your purchase from any school office. Cheques (made payable to North Downs Primary School) or cash (exact money only) are also accepted.

Data Sheet Collection: we are commencing the annual process of sending home Data Sheets this week, on a rolling alphabetical programme, starting with pupils whose surname begins with A-B.

To remind/advise you.....North Downs sends a 'Data Sheet' home with every pupil annually, containing relevant information and contacts for that child as held on the school's database.

These sheets must be signed by someone with legal Parental Responsibility for the child and returned to school, to confirm that data held is accurate. If when the sheet is checked any changes or additions are required, please note these directly and then sign and return the corrected sheet to school.

Every year our admin team has to chase a surprisingly large number of parents for the return of their Data Sheet. This is a very important part of our safeguarding process, ensuring that data for every pupil at North Downs is current - so that, for example, in the event of an emergency or sickness, there is no delay resulting from out-of-date information.

We ask you to look out for your child's sheet in their book bag over the coming weeks and to give it your immediate attention. The sheet should be returned by the Friday of the week following its distribution at the latest please.

Please be aware that in the event of a sheet never being returned (after reminders), we take that as your tacit agreement that data held on the school's system for your child is accurate at the date of sending the sheet home.

Finally, we remind you of the importance of advising your school office, in writing, of any changes that occur during the year, as they occur - address/telephone/email, changes to emergency contacts, medical requirements etc.
