Flanchford Bridge: a Temporary Prohibition Order has been granted, to enable Surrey County Council to carry out bridge replacement works. These works are expected to be carried out within twenty six weeks, during the twelve month period of the Temporary Traffic Order, which comes into effect 1st April. The closure will be in force 24 hourly and will prohibit all traffic (including pedestrians) over Flanchford Bridge and 40 metres either side of the bridge. The closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.
