Primary School Applications

You are reminded that the closing date for Reception applications for September 2015 entry is 15th January 2015.

Surrey Admissions especially welcomes online applications, however parents can also request a paper application form or seek impartial help in completing an application via the Surrey Schools & Childcare Service (0300 200 1004). Full information is available on Surrey's www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions. website at Applications received after the closing date without good reason will be treated as late and will not be considered until all on-time applications have been processed. This may jeopardise the chance of a parent being offered one of their preferred schools for their child.

Breakfast, **Early Bird & After-School Clubs**: you are reminded that payment for attendance at any of the clubs held before or after school at any of our three sites **must be paid for in advance**, via your Tucasi account. Please note that we are unable to permit attendance where there is an outstanding debt. If there is any reason why you have a problem making an advance payment, please speak to your school office.

Free School Meals eligibility: from September 2014 all Reception/KS1 children have been eligible to receive universal free school meal (UFSM). However parents of children in all years (including those now having the UFSM) who are in receipt of certain benefits might also be eligible to receive Pupil Premium for their child. Pupil Premium is an additional funding received by a school for every child eligible to receive free school meals, even if they choose not to have a school meal and bring a packed lunch instead. If you think you may be eligible please ask for an application form from your School Office, complete and return it - and if you are eligible, a member of the office staff will contact you. All applications are treated in confidence.

Paid School Meals: please give this reminder, for parents of pupils having a daily paid school meal (Years 3 to 6), your attention. Surrey Commercial Services (our caterers) require us to advise them of the exact number of pupils having a school meal each day, and cook to that day's number. If a meal has been ordered for your child, but they unexpectedly leave after 11am (due to illness etc.), please be aware that this is too late to cancel the meal, and it will be charged to your child's account.

A final reminder that North Downs closes for the Christmas break next week, on Friday 19th December, at 3-3.15pm for Infants and 3.15pm for Juniors.
