School Meals: next term, the cost of school meals for pupils in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) will be:

payment for the first half term (6^{th} Jan - 13^{th} Feb) **£60.90**

or

payment for the full Spring Term (6th Jan - 27th Mar) £113.40 (excl. half term week)

As always, payment for school meals must be made in advance, ideally via your Tucasi/ScoPay account please. Prior to payment, please check your dinner money account balance. If in credit, deduct this amount from your total payment.

Notification of a meal change from school meals to packed lunches or vice versa should have been made in writing by Friday 19th December (please note this applies to all children - those in Years R to 2 receiving the Universal Free School Meal, as well as those in KS2). If you wish to change next term, a minimum of one week will be required (please hand a letter into your school office on the first day of term).
