REMINDERS AND DATES

SWIMSENSE Summer Crash Course - 25th to 29th July: classes from 3+ years catering for all abilities. All ND pupils plus younger siblings and friends welcome. Groups for non-swimmers, beginners, improvers and intermediates - a maximum of 6 in any group. Private lessons with Emma also available after group lessons. Children taught with the teacher in the water, two groups at a time. Normal pool rules apply and hats must be worn.
