

## Mobile Phone Policy

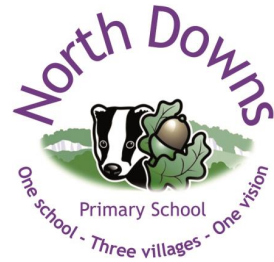
Primary aged children should not need to bring mobile phones into school.

Mobile phones should only be brought into school if there is a real need ie. walking home from school alone.

If you wish for your child to bring in a mobile phone, please fill in the permission form below and return it to the school office.

On arrival, pupils must put their mobile phone into a named bag/envelope and hand into the school office, where it will be kept in a box. It must be collected at the end of the school day.

Please note: North Downs Primary School cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage. Mobile phones are left at owner's risk.
