## **REMINDERS AND DATES**

IMPORTANT - Absence Letters: we remind you that any unexpected absence should be reported to the school office by 9am on the first day of absence - and a signed, dated note should accompany your child's return, which is a DfE requirement, to be made available for the EWO (Education Welfare Officer) during their termly checks. In the event of sickness and/or diarrhoea, the school operates the NHS recommended 48 hour exclusion period: a child may not return to school until there has been a clear 48 hours between their last bout of illness and their intended return to school.

IMPORTANT - Data Collection Sheets: across the autumn term we will be running our annual DATA CHECK. A sheet will be sent home in paper copy for you to sign and return as your confirmation that details held for your child on the school database are up to date. (NB. Any changes may be made directly to this form before returning.) With over 400 pupils' data to check, form delivery to families will be staggered alphabetically, with the first batch (A-C) coming home today (in the case of siblings, with the eldest) and further batches coming home fortnightly. Please look out for and return your form within 5 days of receipt, irrespective of changes or not. Accompanying this form will be an Online Safety Consent Form. This too should be completed, signed and returned, with your Data Collection Sheet please.

IMPORTANT - School Payments: you are reminded that any cheque (or in exceptional circumstances cash) payment made to school, MUST be in a sealed and named envelope. Please do not ask staff/the office to accept loose cheques/cash.

Parent Consultation Evenings: appointment lists for our two Parents' Evenings will be available to sign from Monday 10th October. These lists will be outside the classrooms at Brockham and outside the office at Betchworth & Leigh.
