REMINDERS AND DATES

School Parking: we write following calls from parents and school neighbours drawing attention to potentially dangerous parking. These have been about hazardous parking on pavements and on a sharp road bend at Leigh - often for prolonged periods at the end of the school day; about vehicles parking on the corner of the turning from The Street into The Walled Garden in Betchworth, obscuring lines of vision in both directions (please remember that The Walled Garden is a private road, with no parking available); and about pavements opposite the school site parked up on and zig-zag lines used for drop-off/pick up at Brockham - with additional complaints received that neighbours' drives have been impeded by inconsiderate parking. Our primary concern is for everyone's safety, which is compromised by such parking, as well as keeping inconvenience to our neighbours at a minimum. Please help us by parking with care.

Data Collection Sheets: data sheets are now being sent home with children on a staggered but regular basis. Please remember to check your child's book bag weekly and, once received, return it within 5 days to your school office. Surnames **A to L** have been released so far, which should all have been returned by 31st October, after the half term break please.

Payment should be made online using your Tucasi account (via the link available on the school website). Please remember that payment is due in advance, so by Monday 31st October at the latest.
