#### Safer Internet Day - Tuesday 7th February 2017

Safer Internet Day is celebrated internationally, with events worldwide aimed at promoting the safer use of the internet in our lives. This year the theme is "Be the change: unite for a better internet".

At North Downs, during the day we will be holding assemblies for the children; and Mrs Blumire, our IT coordinator, will be taking individual sessions with classes.

That evening, Mrs Blumire will also be holding drop-in 'clinics' for parents during the Parent Consultations at our Brockham and Leigh sites. No booking is necessary, just 'drop-in'.

#### REMINDERS AND DATES

**PLEASE READ:** we ask that you give your attention to this reminder about school procedures concerning **UNEXPECTED PUPIL ABSENCE.** 

If your child is unable to come to school due to ill health or any unforeseen family circumstance etc. please:

- notify your school office by 9am (the time of morning Registration) on the first day of absence
- phone regularly to update school staff if the illness/absence is of longer duration
- provide your child with a written note on their return to school, signed and dated, to cover their absence for the School Register (a school template is available if preferred, on the school website or from school offices)

As it is a requirement by the DfE that schools monitor absence and verify its veracity, if initial notification of absence and/or subsequent confirmation letters are not automatically provided by parents/carers, it is necessary for admin staff to follow this matter up with phone call and email reminders.

At this time of year, when it is not uncommon for a number of pupils to be absent daily, this can result in a significant amount of staff time being taken chasing parents/carers for this notification. We ask for your cooperation in phoning/writing without need of school reminders please, and thank you for your understanding.

### OTHER NEWS

**Parent Consultations:** appointment lists will be available on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January to sign up for the following week's consultation afternoons/evenings. These will be outside classrooms at Brockham and outside the office at Betchworth and Leigh. **Please note that children should not be brought to the Parent Consultation evenings.** 

**Betchworth Parking:** once again we have received a phone call from an angry and distressed neighbour, following a near miss this week due to a parent parking dangerously on the corner of The Street and The Walled Garden (a Private Road). Please note that it was this lady's intention to report the matter to the police. Whilst we have no authority over parental parking outside the school site, we are hoping that yet another appeal for common sense and consideration for others will result in cars being parked with greater care and respect for both pedestrian and vehicular road users.

**Breakfast Club request:** does anyone have a table top (or very small) fridge they no longer require? Please see Mrs Preston-Heard, who will be very glad to give it a new home at Brockham's Breakfast Club, where theirs is on its last legs!

**Surrey Highways:** we have been advised that Surrey Highways is expecting to re-open **Flanchford Bridge** towards the end of February. They have also advised that there is to be a one day closure of part of **Flanchford Road in Leigh** (between its junction with Church Road/Leigh Place Road and the eastern boundary of Mulberry Cottage) for BT to do some cabling. This may be any day from 6<sup>th</sup> February onwards for a 3-month period, with advance warning signs nearer the chosen day.

**23**<sup>rd</sup> **Dorking (Leigh & Charlwood) Scout Group:** meet in Charlwood and are a recent merger of two small village groups. They are looking to increase membership in both Cubs (8-10½ years) and Scouts (10½-14 years) and are holding an Open Evening for parents and pupils (boys and girls) in Years 4-6 to see what "they get up to" from 6-8pm on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> January at the Scout Centre behind Charlwood Parish Hall (The Street, RH6 0ED).
