Dear Parents, Carers and Children

Easter has come around with surprising speed, but it has been a most enjoyable term with lots of activities and events to enliven and complement the children's learning. Not least was North Downs involvement with and success in various sporting events. We include a round-up and photographs for you to enjoy.

Cross Country: over the year there have been four cross country races in the Dorking Primary Schools League. We had some fabulous performances in all races, which has reflected in the end results, with awards for individuals as well as teams. *Team events:* Year 3/4 Boys - 3rd, Year 3/4 Girls- 7th, Year 3/4 Team - 4th; Year 5/6 Girls - 2nd, Year 5/6 Boys - 1st, Year 5/6 Team -1st. *Individual events:* Year 3/4 Boys - Luke Smyth 3rd; Year 5/6 Boys - Jarrod O Keefe 1st. Lots of our children finished in the top ten in their races, so well done everyone.

Year 5/6 Netball: Dorking Primary Schools District Netball tournaments took place during March. Due to the high number of children who attend netball club we were able to enter 2 teams in both tournaments. The first was Year 6 and both teams played brilliantly, with 'A' team winning their matches by quite a long way. They were just beaten by St Martins 4-3 in the final - a very tense and exciting competition. Then the Year 5 tournament, which was full of anticipation as it was the first time the girls had played matches against other teams. They were such a credit to the school, with the 'A' team finishing in 3rd place. Congratulations to Katie Johnson who received the award for scoring the most goals in the tournament - she got a magnificent 17! Well done to all the girls.

Year 5/6 Tag Rugby: again we were fortunate to enter two teams in the Dorking Primary Schools District Tag Rugby Tournament. Due to the high level of skill in Year 6, our 'A' team won the competition - winning 4 games and drawing 1 - and our 'B' team finished 3rd overall. Officials and parents at the competition commented on the excellent team work from both teams, evident with some outstanding individual and team tries being scored. It was an all-round great day. Well done to everyone involved.
