Packing List

You will also need to provide your child with a packed lunch in a throw away bag for the first day (no glass bottles or sweets please).

The last meal provided by High Ashurst will be lunch on Friday.

Packing List (includes what they wear to travel in: *please ensure that all items are named!*)

Note: High Ashurst provides all bedding.

The children are expected to put their own duvet and pillowcase inside the covers themselves so a bit of 'homework' practice on this would help! All of the activities are outside, and may involve standing still for parts while others are having a go at the activities. Therefore, please make sure that your child has warm layers.

In a separate rucksack/day bag:

- Waterproof trousers
- Waterproof jacket preferably with a hood
- Lunch!
- Water bottle
- Inhalers (if necessary)

In a holdall/small wheelee suitcase (that they need to be able to carry themselves!):

- Wellies/walking boots
- Trainers plus a spare pair (school shoes if no spare trainers available)
- Indoor shoes / slippers
- 2/3 pairs of comfortable trousers
- 2/3 warm jumpers or fleeces
- 3/4 T-shirts
- Pyjamas or nightdress
- Socks
- Underwear
- Towel
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shower gel /soap
- Plastic bags for dirty clothes

We are having a disco on Thursday evening so you may wish to pack something disco-ish! (Please no make-up) **We would appreciate if you could hand in medication to the office before the trip. If that is not possible, medicines (named and in original packets / containers) can be handed in on the morning of departure to Mrs Clark and Mrs Douglass in the hall.**

- Simple *non-electronic* game to play in rooms with friends e.g. cards, top trumps
