## Dear Parents, Carers and Children

This week we are pleased to share some details of the recent annual Dorking Primary Schools Football Tournament in which North Downs participated.

#### Year 5 Boys' Football Tournament

In October two teams of Year 5 boys went to St Martin's School. Both teams played very well, showing great sportsmanship and commitment. It was an extremely close tournament with three teams finishing with the same total points, each having won five of their seven games. It came down to goal difference and on this occasion our 'A' Team came 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### Year 6 Boys' Football Tournament

A week later it was the turn of the Year 6 boys and as holders of the title from last year they were hoping to defend and retain the title. As before it was a fiercely fought competition: our team played extremely well, winning five and drawing three of their matches and this fantastic result meant they triumphed and successfully defended their title!

#### Year 5/6 Girls' Football Tournament

In the week before half term, our Year 5/6 girls took part. Once again it couldn't have been closer. Our team played with huge enthusiasm and produced some great performances. All the matches were tight, with our team winning six, drawing one and losing one and securing 2<sup>nd</sup> place. You will agree, another fantastic result for the school.

# **REMINDERS AND DATES**

**Irresponsible Parking at Brockham Village site:** before half term North Downs received an email from a Brockham neighbour entitled 'Selfish and dangerous parking'. This came with photographs of a specific vehicle parked across one corner of The Smithers into Wheelers Lane and with the following message "*Please be good enough to remind parents of pupils at your school that this is not acceptable because they can't be bothered to walk*". Once again we ask that you show respect for our neighbours, as well as for the safety of all pedestrian and road users near our school sites, by parking with due care and consideration.

# Consultation on admission arrangements for Surrey's community and voluntary controlled schools for 2019

#### Surrey County Council is consulting on:

- proposed changes to admission arrangements for some community and voluntary controlled schools for September 2019
- the admission arrangements for all remaining community and voluntary controlled schools for September 2019

Full details of the consultation and the changes being proposed are available at Surrey Says (<u>www.surreysays.co.uk</u>).

#### Why we are consulting

We have a statutory duty to consult on admission arrangements if we intend to make a change.

The changes being proposed are as follows:

- 1. Cranmere Primary School reduction in published admission number for Reception from 90 to 60
- 2. William Cobbett Primary School reduction in published admission number for Reception from 40 to 30
- 3. The Dawnay School introduction of a feeder link from Polesden Lacey Infant School at Year 3
- 4. Reigate Priory School introduction of a feeder link from Dovers Green and Holmesdale Community infant schools on a tiered basis

#### How can I respond to the consultation?

The consultation on the admission arrangements for community and voluntary controlled schools and the proposed changes will run from Wednesday 1 November 2017 to Tuesday 12 December 2017. If you would like to take part please complete an online response form at **Surrey Says** (www.surreysays.co.uk). Alternatively if you would prefer to respond on a paper form, please telephone the Surrey Schools and Childcare Service on 0300 200 1004 to request a copy. Please note that only response forms which are fully completed with the respondent's name and address will be accepted.

#### What happens next?

After the closing date, responses will be collated and presented to the County Council's decision making Cabinet on 30 January 2018. It will decide whether or not to proceed with the proposed changes as well as determining the admission arrangements for all community and voluntary controlled schools for which no changes are proposed. Cabinet's decision will then need to be ratified by the full County Council on 6 February 2018. Once determined the final admission arrangements for all community and voluntary controlled schools will be placed on Surrey's website at www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions.


## **OTHER NEWS**
