REMINDERS AND DATES

With increased absence during the winter period we ask that you give your attention to the following notes please:

- if your child is unexpectedly absent from school you should contact your school office before 9.30am that day
- if their absence is of more than one day's duration it is not necessary to advise school daily; if the absence is prolonged, please call/email with an update every couple of days
- absence due to vomiting and/or diarrhoea (whatever the cause) has a 48 hour exclusion period, so your child should not return to school until there has been a clear 48 hours since their final bout of illness
- it has recently been decided that it will no longer be necessary to provide written confirmation of dates/reason for sickness absence following your telephone/email notification (except in specific cases, as advised by HT)
- if your child will be absent from school for a planned medical absence (e.g. a hospital appointment), signed written notification is required in advance of the day (whenever possible medical/dental appointments should be made for after the school day)
- a request for any other absence should be made on the school's **Term-Time Absence Request Form** ('Application for leave of absence for exceptional circumstances') in advance, which is available to download from our website http://www.northdowns.surrey.sch.uk/page/?title=School+Forms+for+Download&pid=361

A reminder: to ensure it arrives at its destination, any letter etc. should be handed directly to your child's class teacher or into your School Office please, not left in bookbags (unless you are sure your child can be relied upon to hand it in themselves). Thank you.

School Games Mark Award: we are pleased to announce that we have achieved the School Games Mark Gold Award for 2016-2017. The School Games Mark is a Government led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

Book Fair: thank you to everyone who bought a book/books at our Scholastic Book Fair before Christmas. We raised a splendid £889, enabling us to spend the equivalent amount again on books for the school, with each class choosing a selection for their individual use.
