Dear Parents, Carers and Children

The issue of parental parking has been brought to our attention again and in the hope of improving community relations we ask that you read on...

The issue was raised at Betchworth, but as harmony with school-site neighbours in all our villages is often strained by ill-considered parking we ask everyone for help in this matter please.

The resident who contacted us expressed sympathy for parents delivering and collecting their children in inclement weather etc., but pointed out that any tolerance they and other school neighbours might be inclined to show is quickly lost when vehicles park inconsiderately and sometime dangerously with great frequency.

At each of our village sites there are roads/areas of a road where it is apparent that cars should not be parking - where it is a private road, causes inconvenience for neighbouring homes or risks danger to other road users. Whilst schools have no authority over where parents park, we do ask you to give thought to how your parking/choice of parking place may be impacting upon local residents and road users. Thank you.
