### Dear Parents, Carers and Children

We are delighted to give you a round-up of some of the local sporting events in which our children participated last term...and to say a "very well done" to them all for their enthusiasm, commitment and for each being such a credit to their school.

**Surrey Schools Cross Country** - events took place over the autumn and spring terms. Our Year 5/6 team, comprising Jarrod, Evan, Ronnie, Evie, Erin, Thomas, Katie and Amelie faced tough competition from schools all over Surrey, achieving a splendid 1st place. Jarrod and Evan qualified for Surrey Training Camp having come in their top 20. Some excellent individual achievements were Jarrod (6J) 2nd; Michael (4CM) 2nd; Amelie (6C) 3rd; and Heather (3WM) 3rd.

**Dorking Schools Netball** - Year 6 girls A and B teams and Year 5 girls team all played their matches with great spirit and enthusiasm, showing good sportsmanship. Year 6 A team came 2nd and Year 5 came 1st. Sophie (5MB) was awarded the trophy for 'highest goal scorer' in both her events.

**Dorking School Tag Rugby** - our Year 5/6 team came 2nd on tries scored after some really close play.

Swimarathon - this was a charity event, raising money for NDPS outdoor learning equipment. Two teams took part, with 'Sharks' [Nicholas (6C), Freddie (4CM), Chloe (3WM), Olivia (3T), Casper (4CM) and Josh (6J)] completing 48 lengths and Dolphins [Olivia (4S), Azra (5BM), Charlie (5BM), Philippa (6J), Eoin (3WM) and Ollie (6J)] managing 52 laps.

**Dorking (& Surrey) Schools Football** - after some close play our Year 3/4 boys came 2nd on goal difference. Our Year 3/4 girls came 1st and qualified for the County Final, which was played this week, where they played really well, never giving up despite some difficult games. And so, as we've already said, "well done everyone"!



## **REMINDERS AND DATES**

Safeguarding - we ask for your attention to and cooperation with the following matters please...

#### Collection/Vacating School Premises:

Afternoon collection for KS1 at all our sites is between 3 - 3.15.

After 3.15, the school sites at Betchworth and Leigh are closed unless there are specific events taking place (such as parent consultations/after-school clubs [at Leigh]). Pupils at Betchworth are collected from the school gate, but this is a reminder to Leigh parents that they and their children should vacate the school playground by 3.15pm please.

As well as KS1 at Brockham, KS2 finish at 3.15, so parents/children not involved in one of Brockham's after school events should also vacate school premises promptly when children are released from class please.

We are very fortunate that all three village sites has green spaces and village playparks/equipment for children close to the school sites if parents would like an opportunity to chat and for their children to play after school.

#### School Facilities:

Please note that school toilet, handwashing and first aid facilities are not available after these collection times (apart from pupils involved in after-school activities) unless there is an exceptional circumstance.

#### School Equipment:

School playground equipment/trim trails etc. are only for the use of North Downs pupils, during school hours, when under the supervision of staff.

It must not be used after school **by any child** unless it is part of a teacher-led activity. Nor should it be used by pre-school siblings when waiting to collect older children from school or a club.
