REMINDERS AND DATES

Goulburn Green Betchworth 'closure notice': Betchworth Parish Council has advised that the middle section of the green is to be resurfaced on Monday 21st - Tuesday 22nd next week. The footpath across the green will be closed for the duration of resurfacing, but when parking in the church car park for drop-off and collection you can use The Street pavement alongside Goulburn Green. Parents are asked to observe any restrictions with regard to access to play equipment during this time please.
