Dear Parents, Carers and Children

After our less than favourable dancing weather last week, we are hoping that our sports days will be more fortunate! Here are the details for the two days...

Junior Sports Day - Tuesday 19th June

This will be a traditional sports day with track and field events. **Parents/Carers are invited to come and watch in the morning, starting at 9.15am.** Years 3 & 4 will start with field events. Years 5 & 6 will start with track events. The children are organised in houses for sports day and are allowed to wear the colour of their house:

Drake - Blue / Kingsley - Red / Cook - Yellow / Scott - Green

KS1/Infant Sports Day - Thursday 21st June

All children will spend all day at our Brockham site on Thursday 21st where they will take part in different activities throughout the day. Parents/carers are invited to come and watch in the afternoon. We start at 1.15pm, with the children taking part in a carousel of activities - your programme will show you at which station your child starts. Year 1 & 2 children will also take part in running races after the main sports day has finished.

On both days please ensure your child has a hat and a water bottle; and has sunscreen applied before school.

Mrs Chapman, our Surrey Arts woodwind teacher, popped into assembly to talk about the instruments she teaches whilst giving us a tune or two.
