## REMINDERS AND DATES

**Pupil Medication:** a reminder that if your child requires medication to be taken at school, this should be brought to the office and the relevant ND medical forms completed. All medication must be in its original container, as dispensed by the pharmacist and clearly labelled. Please ensure you check the expiry date of any medication/inhalers before bringing them in to school.

**'New Look' Catering at North Downs, Brockham:** there is a new catering team at our Brockham site. Catering is supplied by Commercial Services SE office and your District Manager is Roz Joyner. Sharon Letts is your Caterer; she has a wealth of experience in Education Catering and has worked for Commercial Services for 12 years, with a real passion for food and excellent customer service. Simonetta Held known as "Simmy" is your Cook. She joined us earlier in the year and like Sharon shares passion and drive! They will be joined by Janine Clea, your Catering Assistant.

Sharon and the team worked closely with the children at Brockham last term, listening to their likes and dislikes, and have tailored the menu to suit their needs. The children are able to choose either the main or the vegetarian option of the day - and in October it is planned to introduce a third option for the juniors, to further increase choice. This option will be things such as filled jackets and Paninis. You will be notified when this happens and a new menu circulated.

We hope you will choose to take up this exciting food offer. KS1 are still free of charge, equivalent to £400; whilst the cost of a meal for KS2 is only £2.30, which is excellent value for a two course lunch with the addition of homemade bread, and a well-stocked salad bar. There is also a choice of daily desserts, so if the dessert of the day is not to your child's liking they can choose from fresh fruit, yoghurt or cheese and biscuits.

There will be a food taster opportunity in October. The new Autumn/Winter menu will be showcased for you to sample the lovely food your children eat on a daily basis, as well as a chance to meet your catering team. Look out for details shortly.
