What we are learning:

English - Completing our unit on Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet.

Maths - Continuing work on the four operations and trying different methods to solve problems.

Art - We are finishing off our work on 2D to 3D and we are hoping to hold an exhibition in the hall to show other year groups what we have produced.

RE - After half term we will be starting a unit called 'CHRISTIANITY: What do Christians believe about the Messiah - and why is it good news?'

Geography - We will be comparing life in New York city with our own to round off our North America topic before half term. After half term we switch from Geography to History and will be learning about Anglo Saxons, Vikings and Norman times.
