### What we are learning

**Maths** - continuing our work on fractions; this continues until the end of term

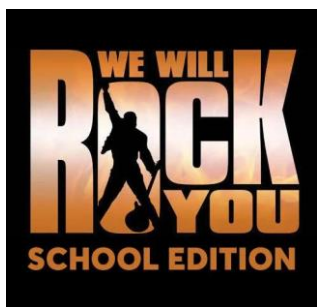
**Art** - We have started making our Viking long ships, linking our DT with our History topic on the Vikings.
