On Saturday 9th March eleven children from Years 3, 4 & 6 (below, top left) took part in a Swimarathon at Dorking Leisure Centre. This is an annual sponsored event organised by the Rotary Club of Dorking, now in its 25th year.

Our swimmers worked brilliantly in two teams, encouraging each other to swim a fantastic 84 laps (the equivalent of 168 lengths!), and raising a splendid £500 between them which will go towards further resources for our outdoor areas' project.

REMINDERS AND DATES

Breakfast/Early Birds/Moles clubs: will all recommence immediately after the Easter break on Tuesday 23rd April.

KS2 School Meals: as we come to the end of another term, a reminder that if your KS2 child has school meals payment must be made in advance please. The school's preferred method of payment is online through your child's Tucasi (ScoPay) account. Please note that cheques are accepted, made payable to Surrey County Council, but no cash payments please, as these are not accepted at North Downs. We also take this opportunity to remind you that a change to your child's lunch preference must be advised in writing, with a minimum of 5 school days' notice.

Summer Term costs are: 1st half term £52.90 and 2nd half term £87.40 (complete term £140.30)

Inhalers/Medication in School: if your child has an inhaler or medication retained for use in school you are reminded to collect it on the last day of term please (and return it with them for the start of the new Term!). We also remind you that it is the parent's/carer's responsibility to ensure that medication supplied and held at school is in date.
