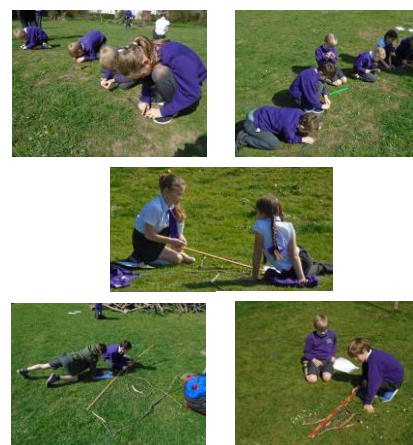

Our community takes a very dim view of **selfish parking and dropping off** on Wheelers Lane and The Smithers. Please show respect to Brockham residents and consideration for our children's safety by not parking or dropping off:

- Outside the school gate or opposite school
- On the zig zag markings
- Near the church bend
- At the junction with Middle Street
- In The Smithers

Extracts from **The Highway Code (www.gov.uk)**

**Rule 243, DO NOT stop or park:**



- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- opposite or within 10 metres of a junction, except in an authorized parking space on a bend

**Rule 244:**

You **MUST NOT** park partially or wholly on the pavement in London, and should not do so elsewhere unless signs permit it.

Parking on the pavement can obstruct and seriously inconvenience pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs.

**We would urge you** in the strongest terms, to park slightly further from the school please, and to avoid driving on Wheelers Lane or The Smithers altogether during peak times.

## REMINDERS AND DATES

We return to the vexed matter of parking around our school premises. Brockham Parish Council and North Downs Primary School have worked together to jointly produce a parking flier (see above left). The aim of this flier is to empower those parents and residents who are frustrated by persistently inconsiderate parking around The Smithers and the northern end of Wheelers Lane, during school drop off and collection times. It is hoped that the flier allows the message about unacceptable parking and dropping off to be communicated without the need for heated discussion on the pavement.

The flier can be handed out or placed under windscreen wipers, so the recipient can read extracts from the Highway Code and hopefully adopt safer, more considerate parking practices.
