### **REMINDERS AND DATES**

North Downs Open Mornings: will be held at Brockham on Wednesday 31st October and Betchworth on Thursday 1st November, with arrival for Headteacher's talk at 9.30am. If you are aware of anyone looking for Reception or Year 3 places in September 2019, please invite them to our open mornings - no booking necessary.

Nasal Flu Immunisation: please be reminded that if you have not yet returned your child's nasal flu form, this is due back in school by Monday 8th October. IMPORTANT - THIS IS WHETHER OR NOT YOU ARE GIVING PERMISSION FOR YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNISATION. Thank you.

Pupil Data Check: we are holding our annual data check across the autumn term. As such, please keep an eye on the newsletter for notification of when your child/children's **Data Collection Sheet** will be coming home in their school bag. This form should be checked carefully, then signed and returned within two weeks, with any changes made to the form as necessary please. Due to numbers of pupils involved, distribution is staggered alphabetically in batches. Data Collection Sheets for surnames A to C are coming home today (in the case of siblings, with the eldest). Please note you should return your form SIGNED irrespective of changes or not.

Sickness Absence: a reminder that if your child experiences vomiting or diarrhoea, it is a Surrey requirement as advised by the NHS, that they be absent for a full 48 hours after the last bout of illness. Please note that it is not possible to make any exception to this rule, the 48 hour exclusion is irrespective of the reason for the sickness.

Coats: please ensure your child has a coat every day (and as the season progresses, hat and gloves too please). The playgrounds can be chilly places even if the day starts sunny...and the infants, especially Reception, frequently spend as much time outdoors as they do inside. You are reminded of the need for all uniform to be clearly name labelled please.

Children's Photos: will be taken next week (Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> at Brockham and Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> at Betchworth and Leigh). If you have children on different sites you will already have received an email concerning sibling photographs. Same site siblings in different classes will be photographed during the normal photo sessions.

Road Closure: we've been advised of patching work on Bunce Common Road between the junction with Newdigate Road and Tapners Road, from 8<sup>th</sup> October. The road will be closed between 8am and 5pm over 2 days. You can find up to date details of the works on www.surreycc.gov.uk/roadworks.
