# Dear Parents, Carers and Children

We are including a reminder for you this week that North Downs strives to be a nut-free school. We have pupils in school with confirmed and suspected nut allergies, and whilst it is not possible to guarantee, we do not knowingly countenance nuts in school.

As such, this reminder is for any parent whose child brings a packed lunch to school, either daily or as a one-off on a school trip, that it should not contain any known nuts or nut products (such as peanut butter sandwiches). We thank you for your cooperation in removing this potential exposure for our children at risk.

# **REMINDERS AND DATES**

**Pupil Data Check:** the next batch of pupils will be receiving their Data Collection Sheets today, surnames commencing M to R (in the case of siblings, with the eldest). Please check this, making changes as necessary and return it to school by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November. Your form SHOULD BE RETURNED, <u>SIGNED</u>, irrespective of changes or not.

NB. We have some Data Sheets overdue for pupils' surnames A to L. Please be aware that this is an important part of school safeguarding, ensuring that the contacts and other data held for your child is up to date.

**Christmas Lunch:** a reminder that if your child usually has packed lunches but would like the school's Christmas lunch on 14<sup>th</sup> December, your order must be placed (and paid for in KS2) by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November.

**Meal Arrangement Changes:** you are reminded that if you wish to make changes to your child's lunch preference, Surrey Commercial Services requires five school days' notice sent in writing to school, or by email to <u>info@northdowns.surrey.sch.uk</u>.

**Breakfast/Early Birds & Moles Clubs:** advance notice that our clubs at Brockham, Betchworth & Leigh will begin on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January for the Spring Term.

**Keeping Warm:** please ensure that not only does your child bring a warm coat every day, but gloves and hats too, now that the weather is colder. Reception children often spend as long in their outdoor classroom as they do inside during the school day - and for all the children, the big open spaces of the playgrounds means they catch every gust of cold wind!
