Dear Parents, Carers and Children

This week we are very pleased to share news of the recent sporting events in which North Downs pupils have been participants.

County Football: in January our Year 6 Boys and Year 5/6 Girls teams, having qualified by winning our local competition, took part in the County Football Tournament. A great event competing against schools from all over Surrey. Both teams played really well and were a credit to our school.

Hockey: also in January two teams of Years 5/6 went to St John's School to take part in the annual Dorking Primary Schools Quick Sticks Hockey Tournament. This was a wonderful tournament with eleven teams taking part. North Downs teams played some brilliant hockey, passing the ball accurately, using the whole team and communicating exceptionally well with each other. They never gave up, showing great team spirit and determination in every match. Well done to everyone who played, it was a really fantastic afternoon of sport and we are very proud of you.

Indoor Athletics: during February a group of children from Years 5 & 6 took part in the Dorking Primary Schools Sports Hall Athletics Competition. This took place at The Ashcombe, where they competed against seven other schools. The children took part in a large range of activities which included both field and track events. It was a wonderful event and the performances from our children were outstanding. Once all the results were determined, the Girls team came 3rd and overall North Downs was 3rd. Well done to everyone involved.



Key Steps Gym Competition: finally, back in December two teams of children - one Year 5/6 and one Year 3/4 - took part in the Dorking Primary Schools Sports Association's annual Key Steps Gym Competition. The children had to learn three routines (Body Management, Floor and Vault) to perform, each being awarded marks up to 10.

Our Year 3/4 team came 4th. They should be very proud - this was a first completion for many of them; indeed some had only just started doing gym. Our Year 5/6 team came 1st overall with some great displays demonstrating co-ordination, poise and controlled performances. What a credit to the school, well done everyone. Congratulations to some individual medal winners too: Katie (Kestrels), Alysia (Eagles), Annabelle (Kestrels) and Isabella (Skylarks)!

Determination of Surrey's admission arrangements for community and voluntary controlled schools and coordinated schemes - 2020 (Schools)

The admission arrangements for Surrey's community and voluntary controlled schools for 2020 and Surrey's primary and secondary coordinated schemes for 2020 were determined by Surrey's Full Council on 5 February 2019. As part of the determination the following changes have been applied:

1. **Furzeffield Primary, Reigate & Banstead:** reduction of Reception PAN from 60 to 58
2. **Wallace Fields Junior, Epsom & Ewell:** change to the measuring points used to assess nearest school and home to school distance
3. **Children previously in state care outside England who left that care as a result of being adopted:** inclusion within criterion 2 for children with an exceptional social/medical need

Any person or body who considers that any aspect of these admission arrangements are unlawful or not in compliance with the School Admissions Code or relevant law relating to admissions, can make an objection to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator. Objections must be referred by **15 May 2019** and further information on how to make an objection can be obtained from the [Office of the Schools Adjudicator](http://www.surreycc.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/schools/school-admissions/admission-arrangements-and-outcomes/determined-admission-arrangements) website.
