Homework

- ▶ Reading – every day, including talking about the book.
- ▶ Maths – try some everyday. Half termly Year 2 KIRFs will be going home to be learnt. These are also on the school website. School push on times tables as now tested at the end of year 4 so there will be weekly testing.
- ▶ Spellings – big focus in Year 2. Home every Friday in diaries, dictation following Thursday. Common Exception words for year 2. Spelling bingo grid every week in homework books.
- ▶ Homework – every Friday due the following Wednesday. This will generally alternate between Maths and English. Any help can be given.

Homework

- ▶ Reading tips (See diary)
- ▶ Reading for understanding
- ▶ Quality rather than quantity
- ▶ Read every night up to 15mins. 10 mins reading, 5 mins questions


- ▶ Diaries – signed and dated everyday
- ▶ Diaries will be looked at by Teachers and Teaching Assistants everyday
- ▶ Watch out for messages on fortnightly Learning Letter



Illness
