English - using "Holes" by Louis Sachar as a stimulus, we are continuing work on narrative writing, focussing on mystery stories;

Maths - calculations using all four operations & formal written methods of short and long multiplication and division;

Geography - exploring the geographical features of North America, looking at the difference between human and physical geographical features;

R.E. - examining the significance of "The Golden Rule" in different world religions;

Science - continuing work on the classification of plants and animals.

There will be a KS1 and KS2 winner, each of whom will be able to choose new games/activities for their classroom.


Please check your pockets, handbags & sofas, and encourage your children to save their coins! Please note we are only collecting 20p, 10p, 5p, 2p and 1p coins.
