REQUEST: If your child is a sheep, can a white adult 't' shirt be sent in for Xmas play.



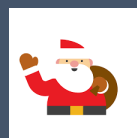
Continuing to develop our knowledge of poetry by writing our own version of The Magic Box by Kit Wright.
