A Maths Update from Mrs Tubb

How you can help your child with their Maths journey...

Just a reminder that we hope all children are spending sometime each night practising their number skills alongside their daily reading. There are a number of ways you can help with this:

- **KIRFS** - (Key Instant Recall Facts) these can be found on the school website in the maths section of the Curriculum area. Each class has a different skill to learn each half term and these are tested just before the end of each half term. If you click on each skill, you will find information explaining them in more detail and suggestions of ways they can practise these skills at home.
- **Times Tables** - Every child has a log in for **Times Tables Rockstars**. This is a very popular game amongst the children and will help them boost their times tables knowledge in preparation for their weekly times tables test. The questions the children are asked have been set by the teachers depending upon which times table they are working in. Please do ask if you have any questions regarding this amazing new resource we have.
- **Sumdog** - Children are still able to log on to Sumdog which will also help them practise a range of number skills.
- And many, many more...I would like to build up a useful bank of maths websites and apps that the children can use to put onto the school website. **If you know of any please do let me know**
