Futures Fridays Spring Term 2026

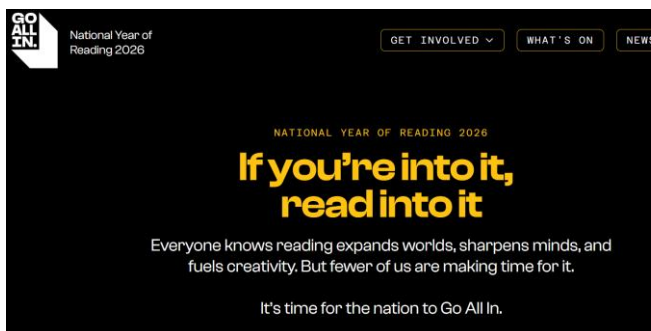
