French - shops and shopping





 When it is dry, make up a treasure map or an uninhabited island. Mark some key landmarks of your own e.g.
 - Bounty Beach
 - Waterfalls of Doom
 - Skull rock
 - Monster Mountain
 - Skeleton Jungle
 - Captain's Cave (Captain's Cavern)
 - Serpent Pass

Add a key and a directional compass.



LOTC (Learning outside the classroom)

Well, we are all learning outside the classroom at the moment but here is a list of some activities which can be easily adapted wherever you are:

- If you can get hold of some seeds, start growing your own fruit/ vegetables. Just be careful not to put them outside until the danger of frost has passed. Seeds can happily grow indoors too! Think of interesting containers to plant them in old wellies, plastic bottles, jam jars...

Think about:

- 1. materials to be used-fabric/paper
- 2. frame shape and size
- 3. visual appeal
- 4. flight.

Complete your own Garden Bird Watch.

Go into the garden, or look out of a window for an hour (you will need to have a few breaks - perhaps take it in turns with another family member). How many different birds visit your garden (if you don't have a garden, you'll still see lots of birds outside)? Use the RSPB site to help identify birds; https://www.rspb.org.uk/birds-and-wildlife/wildlife-guides/identify-a-bird/ keep a tally. You may decide to repeat this on a different day, or a different time. Do different birds come into the garden at different times?

Where do they look for food? On the ground, in trees, from bird feeders? Your probably won't see any skylarks or nightingales but you never know! You could find out where they live and what they sound like! Add anything interesting you notice to the blog.

You could also draw the birds and describe their appearance and behaviour.
