<p>Warm up mental maths; 5 mins each day www.topmarks.co.uk Hit the button www.whiterosemaths.com Home Learning Year 1 Week 2 Lesson 2 - Step 1 - Count in 10s Make a number line counting in tens. Make groups of 10 using counters or pasta. Draw them in your book. Write a sentence for each e.g. There are 3 groups of 10. There are 30 objects. Lesson 3 - Step 2 - Make equal groups. Throw some mixed objects onto a table; can you sort into 5 equal groups of 3, 3 equal groups of 5 and 2 equal groups of 10. Draw in your book and write a sentence underneath. Lesson 4 - Step 3 - Add equal groups Using the groups from lesson 3, draw groups then write as a repeated addition e.g. $5+5+5=15$. Then write a sentence for each. Three groups of five make fifteen. Lesson 5 - Step 4 - Make arrays Use ice cube trays, egg cartons and cake tins. Fill each tray with counters/pasta. Count how many counters in a row. Count how many rows. How many altogether. Write as a sentence. Repeat by counting the columns.</p>	<p>Reading a variety of books at home. Your child could share a book every day. This can be reading a book aloud every day or sharing a book with an adult. Listen to a story being read, Storytime on CBeebies. Watch Newsround and find out what is happening in the world. What did you find out? Is there anything you need help understanding? Create a bookmark, perhaps you could choose characters from your favourite stories. Complete a book review on one of the books you have read - what did you like about it? Would you recommend it to anyone?</p> <p>Remember Oxford reading Owl</p>

'u-e', 'ie' as 'shield', 'ea' as 'head', 'tch' and 'ew'</p> <p>Scan some pages of a book. Write down words you see using your chosen phoneme.</p>	<p>Look at a picture of Monet's Lily pond. What do you see? Make a word bank of nouns and adjectives. Remember to use your phonics and check your spellings.</p> <p>Go for a walk or look in your garden. Talk with someone about what you see, hear, smell and feel.</p> <p>Write a description of what you can see from a window in your house. Try to start each sentence with a sense e.g., I can see, I can smell, I can hear, I can feel. Include some adjectives and the conjunction 'and'.</p> <p>Can you find an old letter? Look at its features. Can you find an address, date, who it's to and who it's from? Cut the different parts out. Lay them face down, shuffle them up and see if you can stick the letter back with the right layout.</p>

<p>Make a rhyming list; play around with made up words.</p> <p>Make your own word search.</p>	<p>Write a letter to someone about what flowers/plants you have seen on a local walk. Remember your Capital letters and full stops. Add interesting adjectives!</p>
