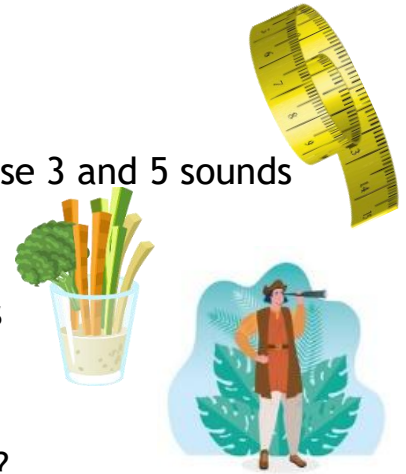
What we are learning

- Phonics - Phase 5 using Bug Club

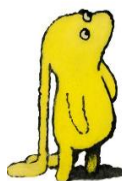
