- Science - Looking for signs of spring and investigations on materials.
- History - Explorers, Neil Armstrong, Amelia Earhart and Christopher Columbus
- RE - Parables
- D.T Healthy food; exploring what different dips taste like
- Computing - Using computers to create artwork
- P.E - Dance and Outdoor games



The children have been enjoying learning about real life explorers. So far, we have looked at Neil Armstrong and Amelia Earhart. They have enjoyed listening to stories, watching videos and reading about their amazing lives.
