Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

Coins.

- Explore 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p and 20p coins. What
 do you notice about them? You might like to
 look at the coin sheet on Twinkl and try to
 match the pictures with your coins.

- Using your coins, see how many ways you can make 5p and 10p.
- Make a pretend shop, choose 5 things to sell in your shop and write a price list showing the cost of each item.
- Open your shop and choose an item to buy, how much does it cost? Which coins will you use to pay for it? Can you use any other coins?

Challenge: Can you calculate any change you might be owed? What is the difference in the amount? How do you know?

- Remember to practise your common exception words for phase 2 and phase 3. You will find these in the front of your child's blue and green sound books.
- Make a list of 10 common exception words.
 Then, write a sticky note for each of them and
 put them around the house. Ask an adult to
 choose a word from the list, you tell them
 what the word is and then see if you can find
 the matching sticky note. How many can you
 find in 2 minutes?
- Listen to Percy the Park Keeper stories (available on You Tube if you don't have these books at home or you may have books).

Weekly Phonics/Spellings Tasks

(Aim to do 1 per day)

Focus on 'ar', 'or' and 'ur' this week.

- Can you think of a word using these sounds?
- Write each phoneme in your word on a sticky note and build your word. Is your digraph at the beginning, in the middle or at the end of your word?
- Play a listening game with your family. Sound out one of your words and see if your family can blend the word. Then, swap roles and see if you can blend the sounds.

Weekly Writing Tasks

(Aim to do 1 per day)

Independent writing

- Can you make a list of all the things Percy might have to do in the park?
- Can you draw what Percy might have for lunch and add some labels?
- Write an invitation to lunch at Percy's Hut
- Write a sentence to let us know how your seed is growing.
- Draw your favourite woodland animal and label it.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week: Our Environment

Where am I?

When you go for your daily exercise, have a close look at what is around you. What do you notice? Draw a map and add a feature each day. You might like to add labels or a key to your map.

A Happy Box

Talk about what Happiness is, you could listen to the song 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams. Make a happy box from an old cardboard box and then draw pictures of things to put inside, which make you happy.
