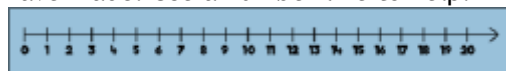
Pick your year and start homeschooling

You'll find daily lessons for homeschooling in Maths and English for every year group, as well as regular lessons in Science, History, Geography and more.



If you can't access the White Rose lessons you could try the following activities:

- How many different subtraction calculations can you make with the answer 11? (e.g. $20-9=11$, $19-8=11$) - use pasta or counters to show subtraction calculations. Write down the calculations you have made. Use a number line to help.



- Make up subtraction stories for the calculations you have made e.g. Max had 20 balloons. 9 of the balloons burst. How many are left?
- Can you work out the addition and subtraction fact families for a given calculation? If we know that $12+1=13$ what else do we know? ($1+12=13$, $13-1=12$ and $13-12=1$)
- Have a go at the questions below using tens frames, part whole models and bar models.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Letter Writing)

(Aim to do 1 per day)

Over the course of this week, you are going to find out about carnivorous plants that live in the rainforest.

Suggested plants to look at are the Venus fly trap and the pitcher plant.

Make a booklet; you will need to spend one day making the front cover with a colourful illustration and heading

Do not forget to say who the author is!

Monday - Identify names and features of carnivorous plants.

Make a front cover for your booklet.

Include a bold heading, picture and your name.

Tuesday - WALT: Write an introduction to your booklet.

Thursday - WALT: Write fact file.

Choose a second carnivorous plant. Make sure you use adjectives to describe their habitat, diet and appearance.

Friday - WALT: Write a comparison.

Which plant do you like the best and why? Use the word because to justify your answer.





