#### Reminders / Dates

Always remember to check the updated Diary Dates on the following page

(Note: dates in italics have been added or changed this week)

School Payments: please be reminded that we are a 'cash free' school. Any payment to school should be made online via your personal Tucasi account. If this is not possible for any reason, payment by cheque is an acceptable alternative with the following provisos please:

- If paying by cheque for multiple items (e.g. trips/clubs/ties) at the same time, please write a single cheque to cover the total amount, ensuring that your child's name is written on the reverse, with a breakdown for what amount is covering which payment.
- Similarly, if paying for school meals for more than one child, please write a single cheque for all meal payments with the name of each child covered written on the reverse.
- The only exception to the one-cheque system, is when paying for school fund items AND school meals at the same time. In this instance, obviously two cheques are required please, as they are paid to different accounts/addressees!

School Swimming Lessons: if you have not yet done so, we remind you that a payment of £13.75 is due for your child's spring term swimming lessons before the end of this term please. If payment is a problem, please see Mrs Ewing in confidence, but we ask that every effort is made to provide at least a partial payment, as each child's contribution goes towards the maintenance and upkeep of the pool and its facilities, so any shortfall from payments not received must be subsidised by the school budget, taking money from other areas of the children's education. Thank you for your help in enabling us to provide the best teaching and facilities possible for a rich and full education for your child. Please be advised that the summer term payment will be £33.00, due at the start of term.

School Swimming - Parent Volunteers: we desperately need parent helpers with swimming next term. We have some classes with no additional adult helpers - Year 6 in particular - and these are in danger of having to be cancelled. Do you have an hour or two a week you could give to assist at one or more of these lessons? Volunteers require DBS clearance (previously CRB), which can be arranged through school if not already held. Swimming lessons are all during the afternoon session, so timings are 12.50pm to 3.10pm, or part of - whatever time you could give would be much appreciated. Please speak to the school office if you are able to help.
