Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

Warm up 5 mins every day - focus on quick recall of number bonds and fact families ($6+4=10$ so $4+6=10$ and $10-6=4$ and $10-4=6$). Please continue to focus on this half term's KIRF (telling the time to o'clock and half past). You can also continue to work on last half term's KIRF (x and ÷ facts for 10x table).

Weekly Writing Tasks (Letter Writing) (Aim to do 1 per day)

All writing activities can be found in the attached PDF.

Monday- Write a retell.

Read the story again. Now in your own words write a retell. You might want to highlight some tricky words from the texts so you can spell them correctly. Write 2 or 3 extended sentences for the beginning, middle and end. Remember to use some time conjunctions, adjectives and conjunctions.

Tuesday- WALT: Plan a story.

Use pg. 14 as a prompt. Talk your story through with an adult. See if you can use some of the words on the sheet to structure the events. Use the story plan template to draw and plan your story. Remember the middle should be about a problem!

Wednesday- WALT: To write a beginning

Use capitals and full stops (remember to use capitals for names of people and places). Use time adverbials and conjunctions. Try to add good adjectives. Can you include some verbs?

Always remember to keep your handwriting neat and use your phonics to spell tricky words.

Thursday- WALT: To write a middle

Use capitals and full stops (remember to use capitals for names of people and places). Use time adverbials and conjunctions. Try to add good adjectives. Can you include some verbs?

Always remember to keep your handwriting neat and use your phonics to spell tricky words.

Friday- WALT: Write an ending.

Make sure you read your work back. Check your sentences make sense. Have you used capital letters and full stops correctly? Is your handwriting neat? Check your spellings.




If you can't access the BBC bitesize/White Rose lessons you could try the following activities:

Count the fruits and draw the jumps on the number lines.




- Get a collection of 5p coins and count up how much money you have.


