un- goes at the beginning of a word. It is called a prefix.

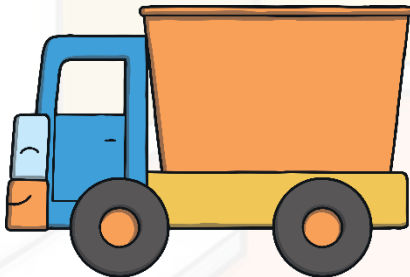

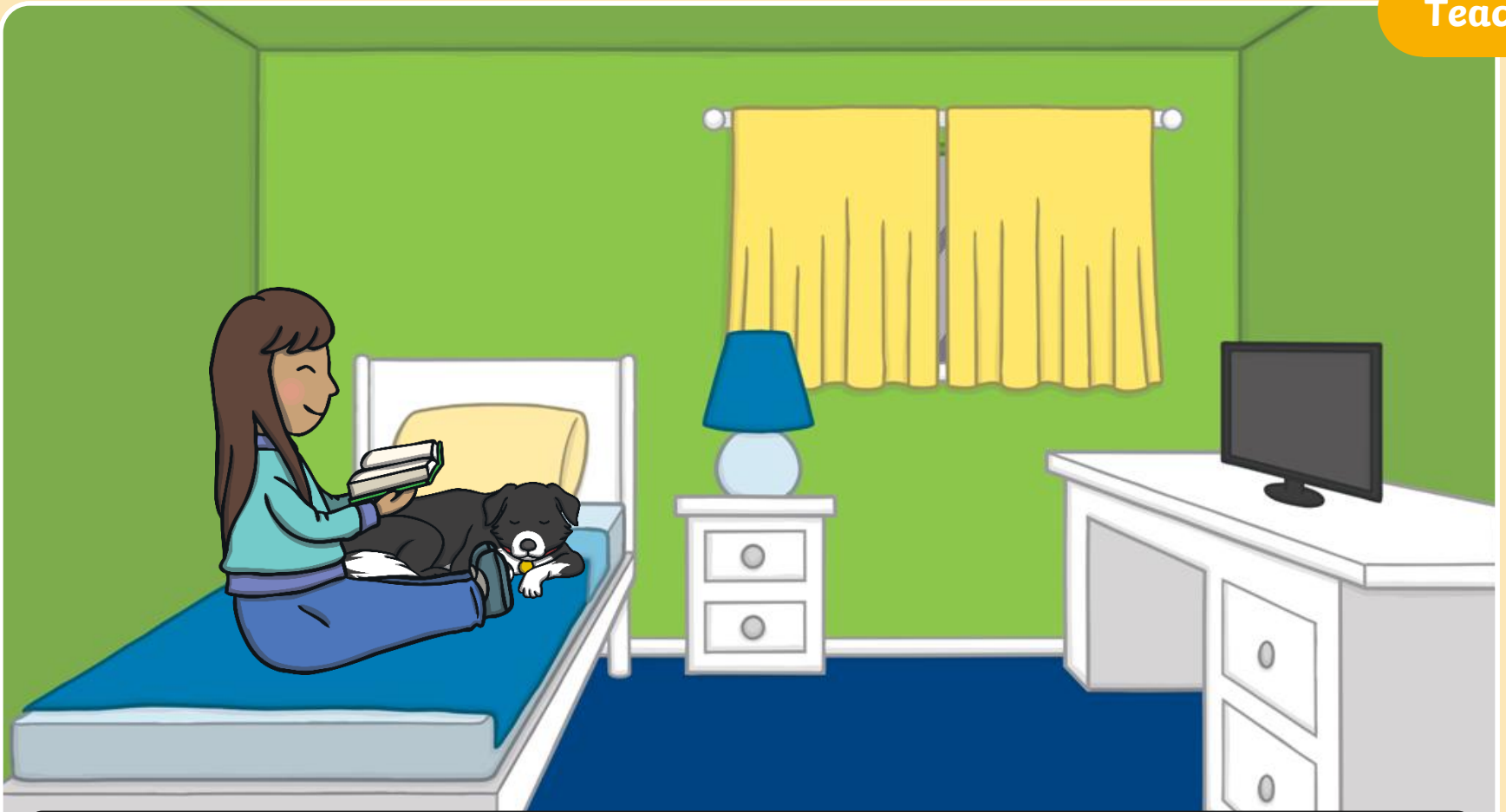

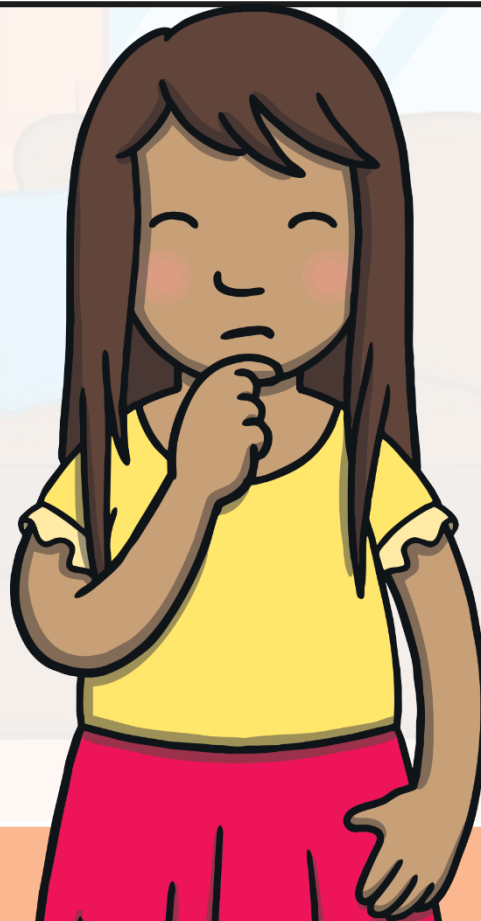
