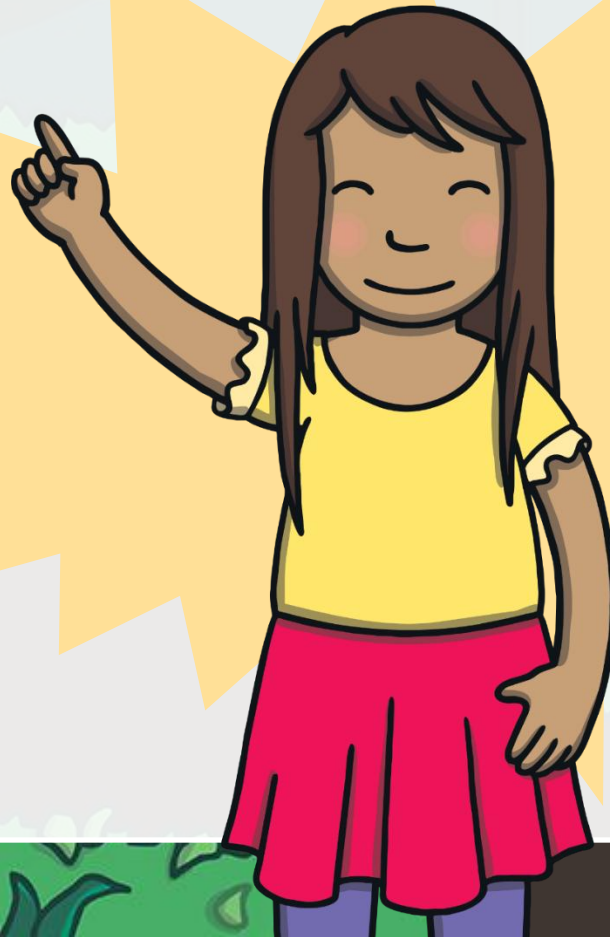



Adding un- The Amazon Rainforest

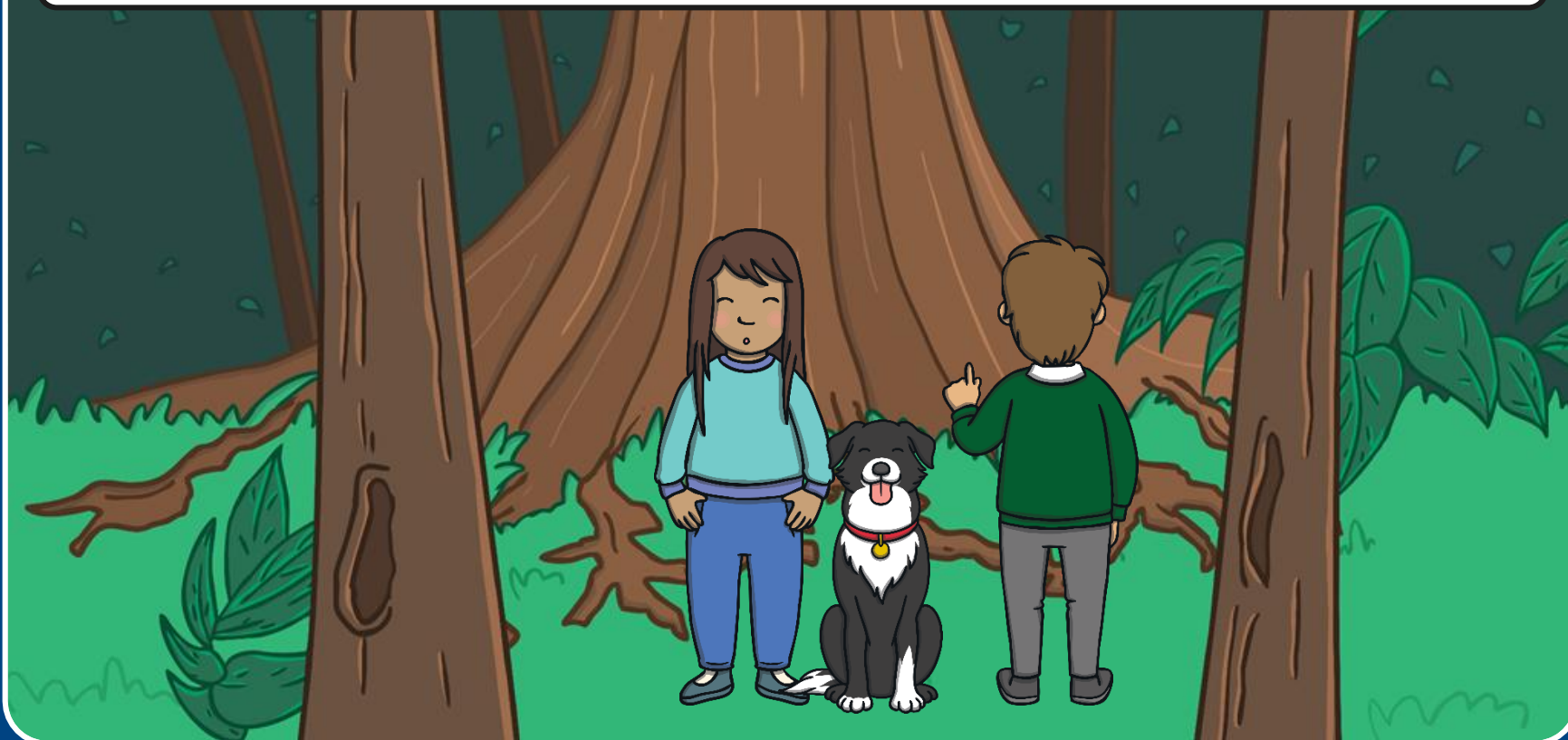

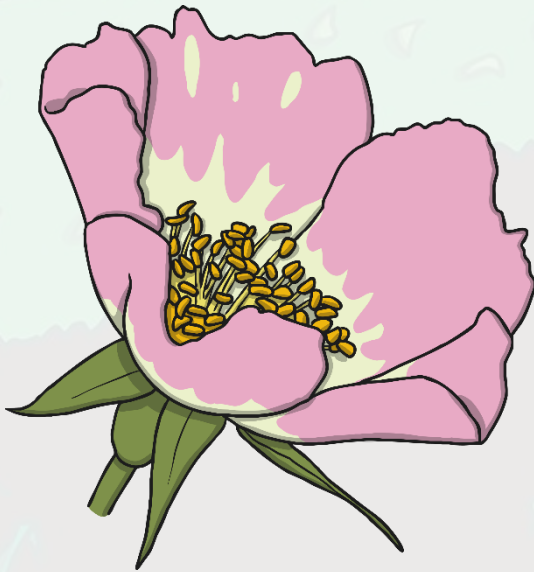

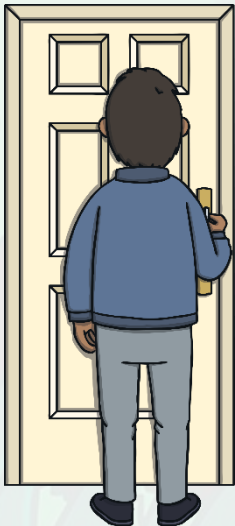
Plant Word and Picture Match

There are also lots of plants on the forest floor. Read the word on the plant and match it with the correct picture.



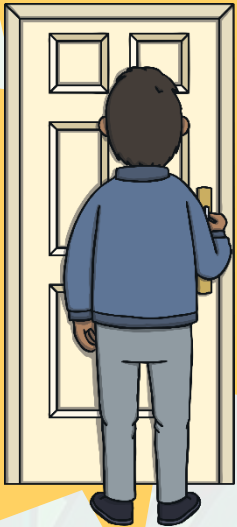
