What we are learning

- English - Letter writing; capital letters and question marks.
- Phonics - looking at different ways of making the 'c' (c - card, k - keep, ck - clock, ch- chemist) and 's' sound (ce - nice, ci - cinema , cy - cymbol)
- Maths - Fractions - finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shapes and quantities
- Science - Wild flowers, garden plants and trees; identifying deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Art - Watercolours and exploring mixed media.
- P.E - Maypole dancing and outdoor games
- Computing - Maze builders; understanding simple algorithms.
- Geography - The UK, capital cities and seas around the U.K.
- RE - Understanding Islam and what is important to Muslims
