

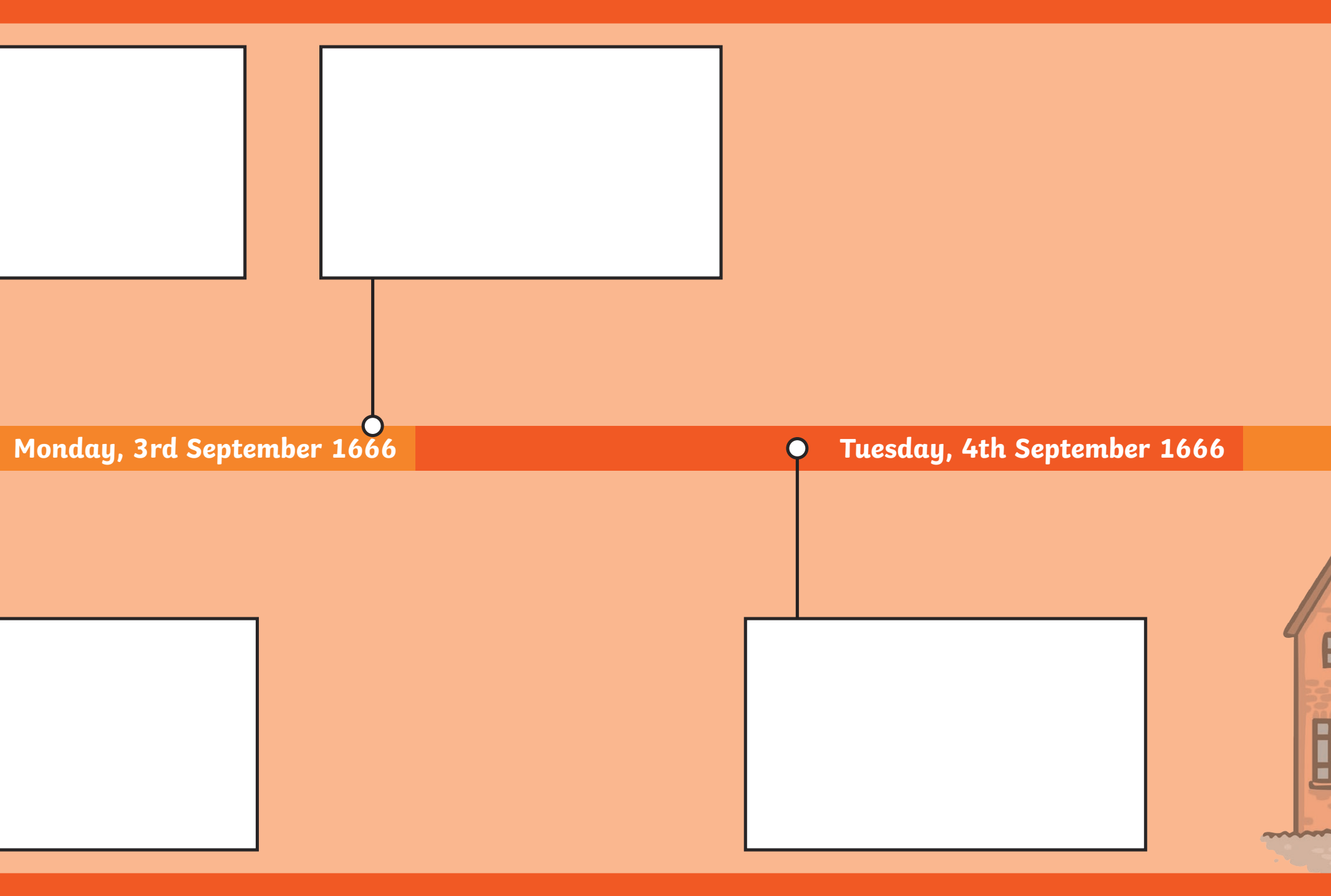

### Early Monday Morning

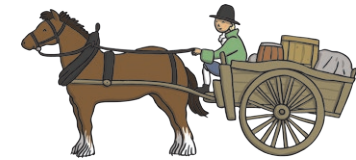
People carry their possessions to safety using boats on the River Thames.
