


Teach

Today, we are learning to read words that contain **ea** saying /ee/.


The graphemes 'e', 'ee' and 'ea' are all used to spell the /ee/ phoneme in words such as 'be', 'bee' and 'bead'. There is not a consistent rule for when to use 'ee' or 'ea' so children will need to learn which grapheme to choose.






Sometimes, **ea** can make the /ee/ sound. Click on the seals to reveal the **ea** saying /ee/ words. Teach
