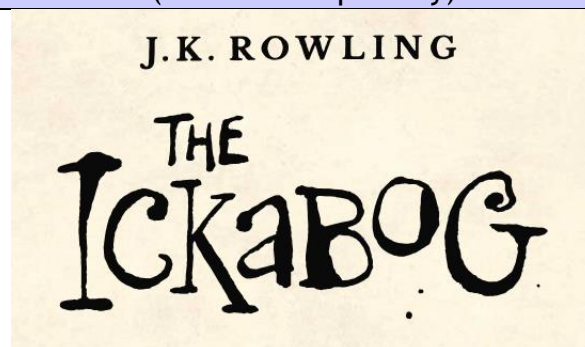

	<p>On the school website you will find a story mountain planning sheet.
