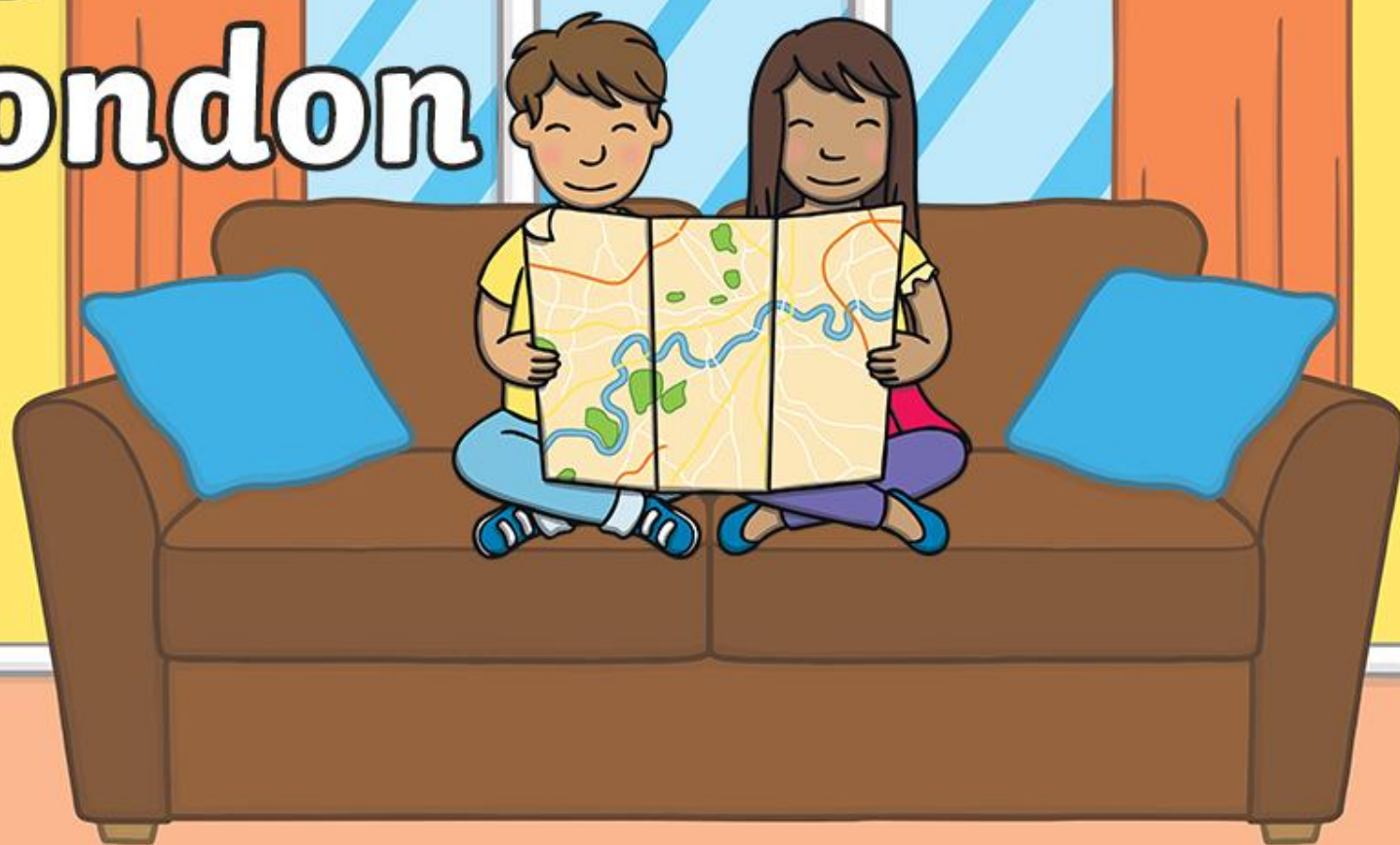




oy saying /oi/ London

“Maybe,” said Sam. “Do you **want** to go?”

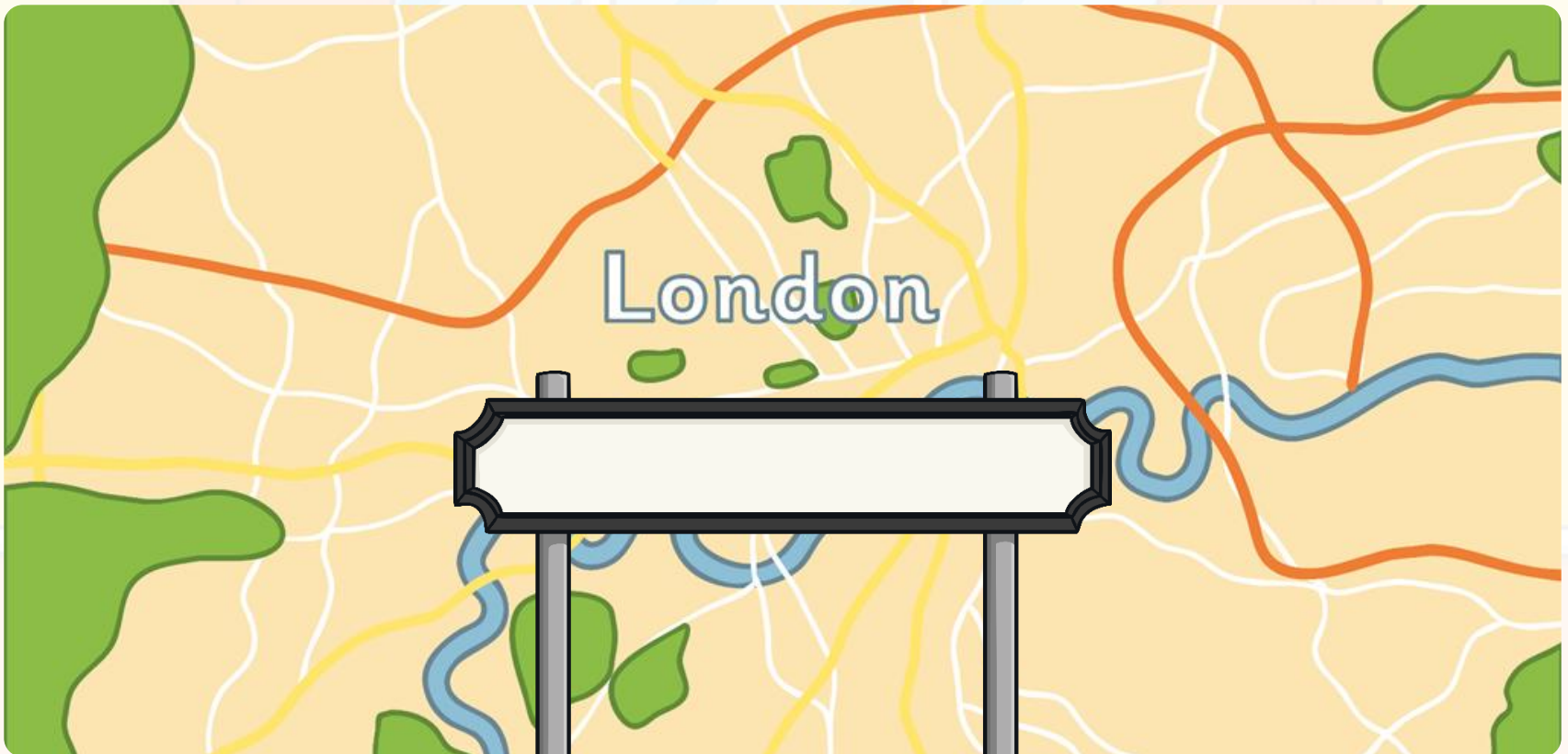
“Yes!” replied Kit.



Kit and Sam are thinking about what they would like to do if they visited London. Read the sentences in the speech bubbles and match them to the correct picture.





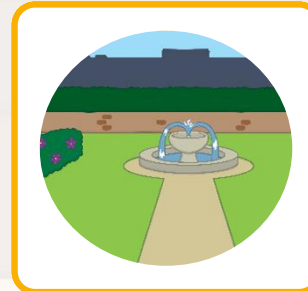
