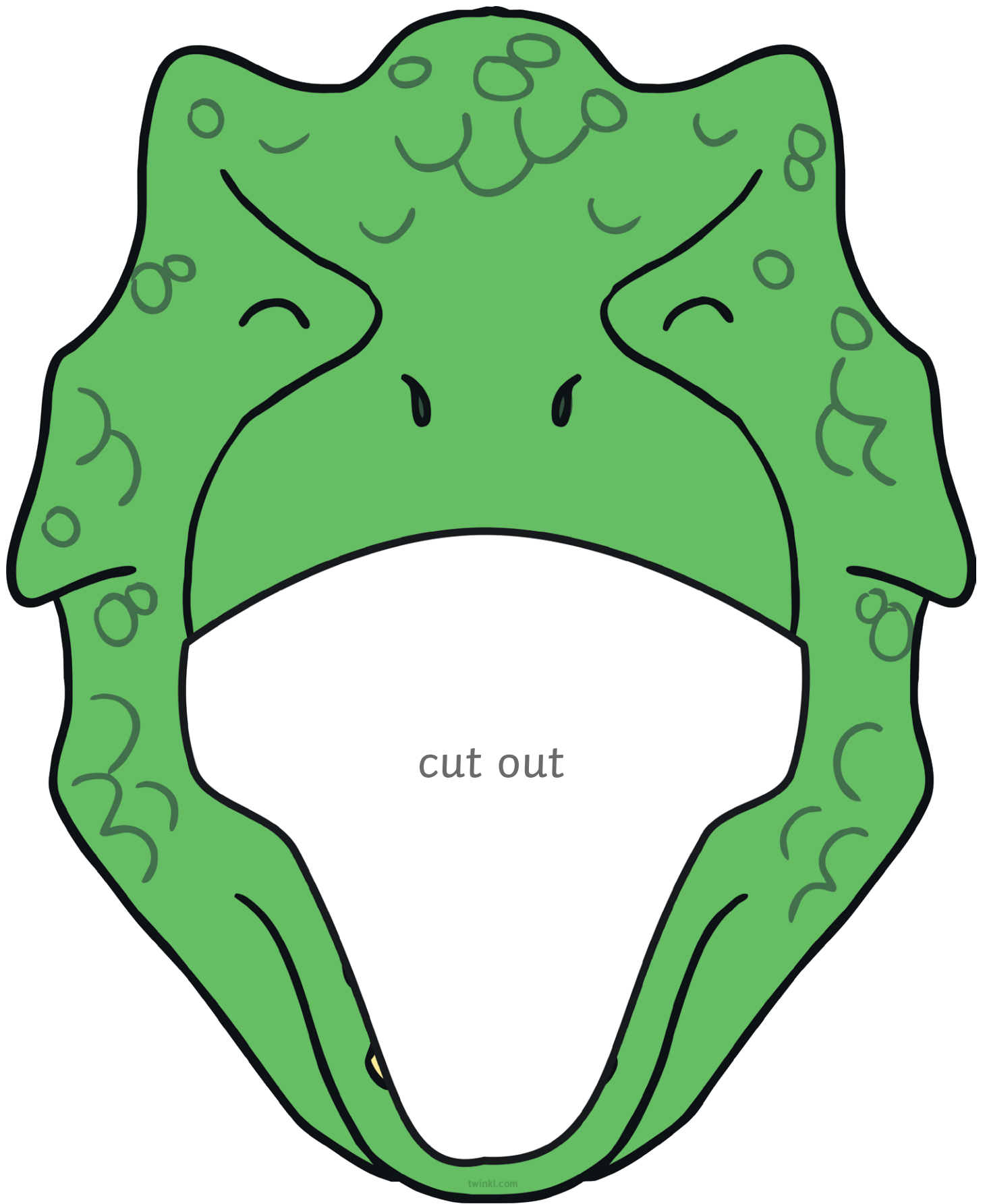


Real or Nonsense Leaf Words

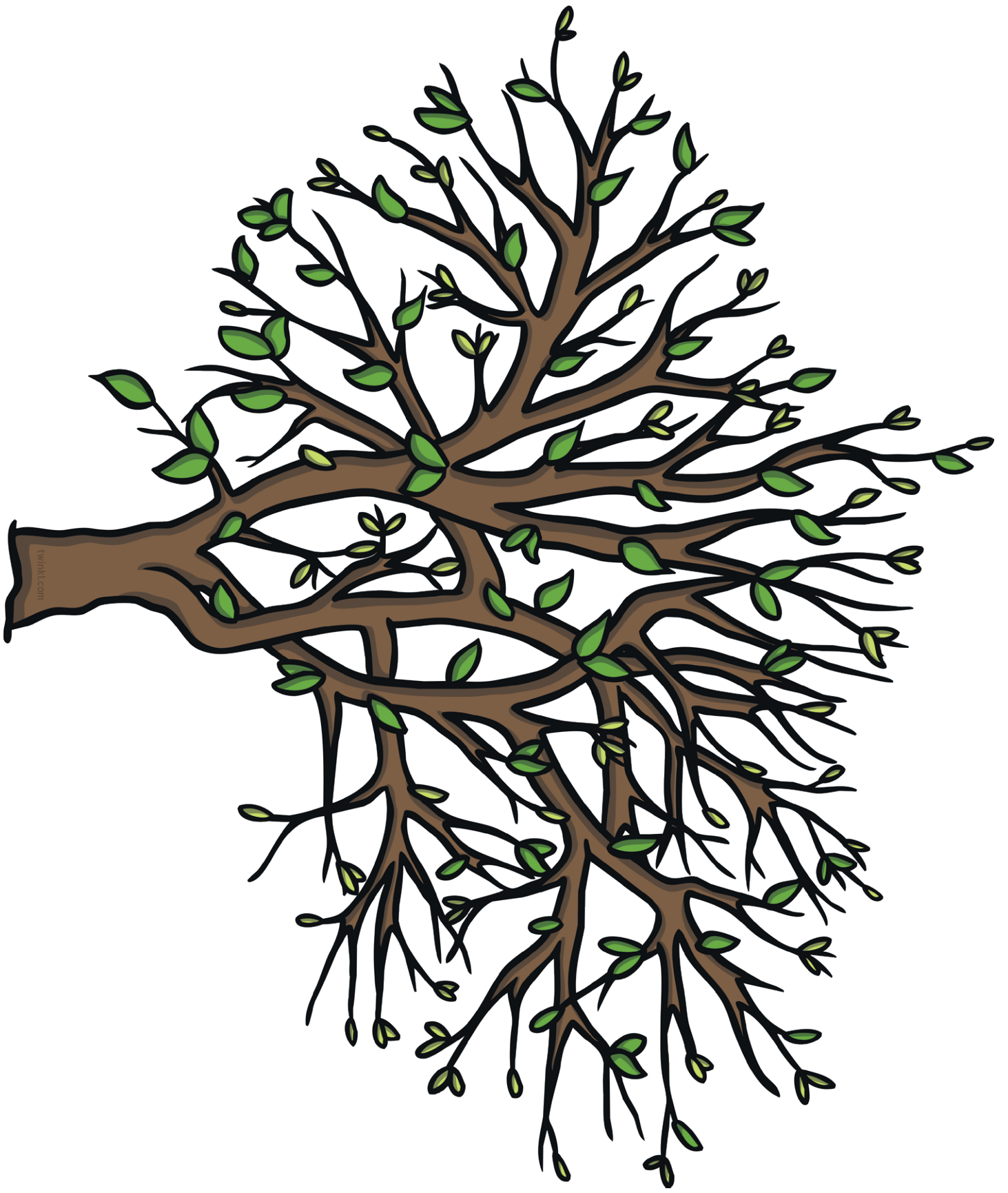


Level 5

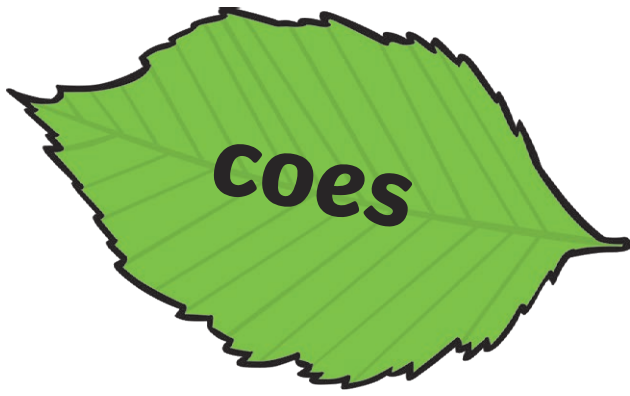
